Paraglide into the Six Senses Hideaway, Zighy Bay, Oman

The hotels in and around Dubai can be fabulous, but they all offer pretty much the same arrival experience, which is a five-metre dash from the climate-controlled limo into the air-conditioned lobby, over some marble paving. Efficient, yes, spectacular, no. Which is just one good reason for visiting the Six Senses Hideaway Zighy Bay (formerly Evason Hideaway). It's in an "exclave" of Oman that's nearer Dubai than it is the rest of Oman, a rocky finger jutting accusingly towards Iran across the Straits of Hormuz, Ringed by steep, arid mountains, the luxury resort's preferred method of arrival is to strap you to a paraglider (with instructor) at the top of a mountain, and watch you sail all the way down to the resort in the bay. Unforgettable.

Don't forget To get the hotel's photographer to take a picture of you in mid-air.

Burn the autobahns in Germany

If you want to put pedal to the metal and keep it there, there's only one place for it: Germany's derestricted autobahns. See the world blur as the engine sings for miles on end, with no fear of the police (only of instant death if you lose control). But remember, at 150mph, a curve becomes a treacherous corner. Take your own car or rent a Mercedes S-Class (top speed: 155mph) or Porsche 911 (180mph plus) at Munich airport and head for the straight, generally quiet highways.

Charter a party schooner in the Croatian islands

In terms of a balance between sea and scenery, relaxation and play, sailing Croatia's



island-infested coastline beats more traditional Med destinations hands down. On board Dalmatian Destinations' 30-metre schooner, you and nine friends get a waterski boat, canoes, snorkelling gear, air-con and contemporary-chic bedrooms, and a crew that knows every cranny of this striking but tortuous coastline.

Don't miss The table they'll book for you at Carpe Diem Hvar, currently the hottest nightclub between Ibiza and Mkyonos, and harder to get into than the Vatican's account ledgers.

Panama is a strange destination. Part of it is the kind of Americanised non-place you'd flee to if you were pretending to be dead, part-transit zone and part-central American wilderness - making it a very compact place to visit for an all-in-one experience. It all starts in the excellent jazz bars of Panama City, whose old town is UNESCO listed and as pretty as anything on the mother continent; then you spend the night in a volcano crater, and finish off at Coral Lodge, where those who don't want to dive can take glassbottomed kayaks around a network of waterways and reefs.

Don't miss The sloths hanging from their trees. We want their life.

Dive Desroches, Seychelles

Diving. In a word, that's why you go to Desroches. Sure, the suites are lovely, the pool is blue and it's luxurious, yada yada, but diving is the differentiator. And you don't need to be a pro. Coral tunnels and walls abound, and the sea life is astounding. Intermediate divers should head for the canyon, formed from stone blocks; experts to the 60 metrelong tunnel, which ends in a coral room where nursery sharks snooze. All divers will see gorgonian fan corals, shoals of snappers and fusiliers, sweetlips and turtles, seagrass pipefish, Napoleons, bumphead parrotfish... and the colours are positively Disney.
